Jesus Gives Us His Body and Blood: The Eucharist

Dear People of God, we celebrate the Twentieth Sunday in Ordi- The flesh and blood of the Son of Man also denote the Redeemer in nary Time, Year B. Filled with the Spirit, we make Thanksgiving to man's nature, Christ Crucified; plus, the redemption wrought by Bread and Wine. To eat of it requires leaving behind our simpleness, ignorance and folly so that we may live and walk in the way and eternal life. These are called the flesh and blood of Christ beof insight. This image expresses God's Communion with humanity, cause they are purchased by the breaking of His Body and the shedinviting us to be wise, not foolish, but to meet together to pray, sing and reflect. Jesus Christ offers His very Body and Blood for those The Wisdom of God is made bread for all.

Jesus fed the people and spoke about a more important bread coming down from heaven. Today Jesus affirms clearly that the lifegiving bread He has been talking about is Himself. He invites those who are listening to Him to eat His flesh and drink His blood so that they might live now and be raised up on the last day. This is the challenging that the people have to decide whether to continue to follow Him or to leave Him altogether. Jesus insists forcefully on the need to eat His body and drink His blood. Through this powerful image of eating of His body, Jesus is inviting Christians to enter into a deeper relationship with Him, to identify with His person. For Jesus, it is not enough to have faith in His Word, one must also eat ence in the whisper of life; or like Joshua to do battle for our souls and drink His body and blood to possess eternal life.

Eating, as we know, is a sign of communion. We do not usually sit down to a meal with enemies. We invite people to eat with us to celebrate our friendship with them. Thus, Jesus invites people for a meal because He wants to celebrate the love and unity that exist between Him and them. But Jesus does not merely ask people to eat a meal with Him. He tells us that the food is His Body. For the Old Testament people, it was normal to eat part of an animal killed in a sacrifice. Eating an animal that was sacrificed to God meant entering into communion with God (1 Cor 10:18). Similarly, in some traditional African religions, to share a sacrifice offered to the spirits of the ancestors meant entering into communion with them. To eat a sacrifice offered to God is to renew our communion and covenant with God. The Flesh of Jesus is Jesus Himself, His whole Person. So, if Jesus invites believers to eat His Body, He wants them to enter into communion with Him, and be assimilated with

Drinking the blood of Jesus was a very strange and unique invitation. When the Israelites offered sacrifices, they ate the flesh but did not drink the blood. Blood is life, and life belongs to God. When God made His covenant with Israel, Moses slaughtered the animals and then took half of the blood and spilt it on the altar and the people (Ex 24:1-7). This was to show that the people and God (represented by the altar) committed themselves to each other for May God lead you home safely and sound. Pax! life. To eat in God's presence is to seal the covenant, the blood pact between God and His people. Body and blood are life. To eat the body and to drink the blood of a person, says in symbolic language, that the one who eats receives the other person fully into his or her life. Receiving the body and blood of Jesus is to receive His life. Jesus wants to dwell in all His faithful, and when He does, we have a new life in us, that of Jesus. We can thus confidently say with St Our Lady of the Holy Rosary, Pray for Us. Paul: "It is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. The life I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave Himself up for me" (Gal 2:20).

God for the Bread of Life. Eating this Flesh and drinking this Blood means believing in Christ. We partake of Christ and all His benefits by who long for life. In this way, we will be filled with the Holy Spirit. faith. The soul that rightly knows its state and wants, finds whatever can calm the conscience and promote true holiness, in the Redeemer God manifested in the flesh. Meditating upon the Cross of Christ (offer of His Body and Blood) gives life to our repentance, love, and gratitude. Christians live by Him, as our bodies live by our food. Believers live by Him, as the members by the head, the branches by the root; as He lives, we shall also live.

Being the Real Presence of Christ, ever present even when nobody is around, the Eucharist offers renewal and nourishment to the Christian life. It is Christ accessible to all who come to Him.
