He was born, and for this He came into the world, to bear witness to the truth. All who are of the truth hear Christ's Congratulations to our dear and fresh Graduates. Ayeekoo! As we voice.

The kingdom of Jesus is fundamentally a witness to the truth. Therefore, it is opposed to falsehood and oppression. Such a kingdom cannot be set up by force. Everyone is called to listen to the voice of truth and to decide freely on which side of it to stand. Such a kingdom is eternal in time, universal in scope, and very understanding of kingship: the more reason Jesus slipped away whenever people tried forcefully to declare and make Him king. Although all things are created through Him and for Him, to show the depth of His Father's love for humanity, Jesus pre-eminently demonstrated His Kingship through His suffering and death, freeing us from sin and death, not by being served.
